

SEXTANT 2013

'KAMAL' CABERNET SAUVIGNON



APPELLATION: Paso Robles, California

WINEMAKING: Estate Grown. 75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 11% Malbec, 7% Merlot, 5% Petite Verdot, 2% Cabernet Franc. Aged 22 months in 41% new French oak.

TASTING NOTES: Opulent, textured, and precise, the 2013 Sextant Kamal takes its cue from Bordeaux tradition through the care taken in assembling this blend. The nose on this vanilla and marmalade-perfumed wine encapsulates a delicate red apple skin while the seductive toastiness, elevated by its bountiful bright acidity, adds to its rich aroma. Notes of uncooked French bread and Rainier Cherries can be extracted from the limber tannins, allowing the flavors to coalesce on the mid-palate where hints of briary, tobacco leaves, and chocolate spice become evident. The flavors mingle softly again before taking leave in the persistent and polished finish.
