APPELLATION: Paso Robles, California

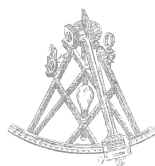
WINEMAKING: Marselan is another fun hybrid varietal that we source from our RBZ Vineyard in the El Pomar sub AVA. Being one of the first to plant Marselan in California, we take great pride in this wine each year. After being gently destemmed at the winery, we ferment this lot in stainless steel before pulling free run juice into French Oak barrels where it ages for 18 months.

TASTING NOTES: The second in our lineup of cross bred varietals, Marselan showcases the union of Grenache and Cabernet Sauvignon. The aroma is highlighted by rich notes of boysenberry, cinnamon and fresh harvested truffle. As this wine opens up you'll also find hints of coffee and fresh tobacco leaf. The palate erupts with bright, strawberry like acidity that transforms to a more gritty, leather like tannin structure that carries all the way through to the finish.
