



2021 KAMAL RESERVE CABERNET SAUVIGNON



APPELLATION: El Pomar District, Paso Robles, California

WINEMAKING: 2021 is one of the best vintages in recent memory for cabernet in Paso Robles. An even ripening season across our blocks allowed us to pick each at its peak maturation. We have about ten blocks of cabernet planted in our estate RBZ Vineyard that bring a different layer to Kamal each year—deep fruit tones, earthy spice, bold tannins, and a smooth finish leave much to enjoy!

TASTING NOTES: Those looking for an exemplar of a Paso Robles Bordeaux-style wine can find it in the 2021 Sextant Kamal, a reserve cabernet with a tradition nearing two decades. Marked by refinement and elegance, fragrant violets, anise, and sage meld with seamless contours of black cherries, plums, and currants. Textured with limber tannins and lively acidity, integrated layers of mint, mesquite, and eucalyptus become evident on the pleasing finish.
